## What We Do

The Great Reset is an initiative to bring conversations to your community. It is a gathering of people who want to have open, respectful discussions. Once a month, participants meet (in-person or digital) to discuss a topic or idea and hear a variety of perspectives from other participants. These conversations provide a space to listen and share, sometimes disagree, yet walk away enriched, anticipating the next discussion.

## What do we talk about?
