Remember to ask to record and PRESS RECORD

(1) Affordable Housing

- When you hear affordable housing...what does that mean?
- Is affordable housing a problem in the United States? Is it a problem in your community?

(2) Homelessless & Affordable Housing

- Is homelessness affected by the lack of affordable housing?
- Who is at risk for becoming homeless?
- What influences one's possibility of becoming homeless?
- Is there a moral obligation to care for the homeless?

(3) Affordable Housing Solutions

- What are some examples of what's worked or what you'd like to see?
- What are the financial pros/cons to managing the affordable housing availability in your community?
- What are the financial pros/cons to helping get the homeless into 'affordable housing'? How best to accomplish this?
