(2) What is Universal Healthcare?

As defined by the World Health Organization: Universal health coverage (UHC) means that all people and communities can use the promotive, preventive, curative, rehabilitative and palliative health services they need, of sufficient quality to be effective, while also ensuring that the use of these services does not expose the user to financial hardship.

A peak behind the curtain is that healthcare has been politicized since 1912 when Teddy Roosevelt's platform included some type of universal healthcare, then again in 1945 when Truman sent a bill to congress seeking a solution and implementation of National HC, finally it was Johnson who brought 'it' to fruition in 1965 with medicaid/medicare. And, of course, we saw the passage of the ACA in the early 2010's.

Part of Johnson's social reform movement, known as 'The Great Society," was to eliminate poverty and racial injustice
