(1) Getting acquainted and comfortable

5 - 10 min.

Welcome

(2) Patriotism

30 - 35 min.

- What makes someone a patriot?
- Is “my country, right or wrong” a creed of genuine patriotism?
- Do you feel that the label of patriotism has been hijacked, and why or why not?
- How do you feel when the people who stormed the US Capitol on January 6, 2021 call themselves patriots or when others label them as patriots, and why?
- What can your country do to encourage genuine patriotism?

(2) Nationalism

20 - 25 min.

- What is nationalism?
- How is nationalism different from patriotism?
- Should we encourage or discourage nationalism, and why?
- Is America First a form of nationalism? What do you think of America First, and why?
- How different or similar is nationalism to fascism, and why?

(4) Globalism

10 - 15 min.

- What is globalism? Probe for both economic and identity characterizations.
- Should we encourage or discourage globalism, and why?
- Can a person be both a globalist and a nationalist, and why or why not? Why do some people who describe themselves as patriots denigrate others as globalists? Probe for anti-globalism associations with anti-Semitism.
